GOVERNMENT OF CANADA INVESTMENTS STRENGTHEN THUNDER BAY, SUPERIOR NORTH AND RAINY RIVER REGIONS

Community Adjustment Fund Initiatives

Namaygoosisagagun First Nation **\$563,135**
This funding will enable Namaygoosisagagun First Nation to construct a saw mill and small business centre.

Regional Food Distribution Association of Northwestern Ontario **\$518,281**
This CAF investment will help the Regional Food Distribution Association of Northwestern Ontario to retrofit a local building in Thunder Bay.

Ojibways of the Pic River First Nation **\$410,060**
The Ojibways of the Pic River First Nation, based in Heron Bay, will acquire and retrofit a former private high school to house a small business complex.

Lakehead University **\$391,820**
With this CAF investment, Lakehead University will hire three technicians in key areas (soil, bio-refining and materials sciences) as well as an individual to develop and market these new capabilities.

Couchiching First Nation **\$318,695**
Couchiching First Nation will use this CAF investment to upgrade hydro and road infrastructure on the reserve.

The Corporation of the Township of Terrace Bay **\$300,000**
The Township of Terrace Bay will develop and install municipal signage, as well as complete landscaping and enhancements to the community's downtown.

The Corporation of the Municipality of Greenstone **\$240,000**
Greenstone will construct a multi-purpose building to house a clinic, library, legion hall, public meeting space and tourism information centre.

The Atikokan Intergenerational Centre for Arts and Alternatives **\$166,820**
With this funding, the Atikokan Intergenerational Centre for Arts and Alternatives will develop and implement a strategic business plan to ensure the long-term sustainability of the Centre.

The Corporation of the Township of Emo **\$111,900**
This CAF investment will enable Emo to extend water, sewer and streetlights on Byng and Adelaide Streets to service an industrial park and agricultural fairground.
