THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA INVESTS IN GREATER SUDBURY REGION

COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES

\$1,111,823

City of Greater Sudbury

FedNor funding of \$451,000 will allow the Greater City of Sudbury to proceed with the planning and development of the new Northern Ontario School of Architecture.

An additional FedNor investment of \$225,000 will enable the Greater City of Sudbury to assess under-serviced industrial land to determine the viability of future development.

Music and Film in Motion

Building on the organization's past successes, FedNor funding of \$420,000 will allow Music and Film in Motion (MFM) to implement the next phase of its long-term strategic plan. Over the next three years, MFM will broaden its presence throughout Northern Ontario, foster the development and promotion of the region's music and film industries and create new opportunities for Northern Ontario communities and artists.

Prise De Parole Inc.

This not-for-profit francophone organization will use \$11,550 in FedNor funding to hire a consultant to develop and implement management and performance measurement tools, helping to ensure the long-term success of Prise De Parole Inc.

Rainbow Routes Association

A FedNor investment of \$4,273 will allow this not-for-profit organization to design and publish maps of Sudbury's non-motorized trail system. Once complete, the maps will provide an overview of the entire city and highlight individual trails, allowing the community to promote its natural beauty and strengthen its local tourism industry.

SMALL BUSINESS INITIATIVES

\$250,000

Nickel Basin Federal Development Corporation

Based in Sudbury, this not-for-profit Federal Development Corporation will receive \$250,000 in operational funding to administer a community investment fund established to provide small and medium-sized businesses with repayable loans, loan guarantees and equity investments.

FedNor funding of \$44,857 will allow this not-for profit francophone organization to implement a promotional campaign and install information and communications technology applications to ensure its ongoing success.

YOUTH INITIATIVES**\$109,167**

Four recent graduates will gain valuable on-the-job experience through FedNor's Youth Internship Program (YIP), helping the successful candidates to make the transition from the campus to the workplace.
